How to reach us ...

by Air:

- From Heathrow or Gatwick, take the Road/Rail links to Bristol Temple Meads (Rail) Station or Bristol Coach Station.
- From Bristol Airport there are daytime bus links to Temple Meads Station and the Coach Station every 20 minutes or half-hour as well as car rental and taxi services. See below for links from these stations. By car from Bristol Airport take the A38 to central Bristol, then see road instructions below.

by Rail:

- Preferably arrive at Temple Meads which is under a mile (a little over a kilometre) from the hotel and is well served by taxis and buses. By rental car follow the road instructions below.
- Bristol Parkway is twenty minutes out-of-town by taxi. Taxi services and infrequent bus services are available.

by Coach:

The Coach Station is under a mile (just a kilometre) from the hotel with a taxi rank at the lower exit.

by Private Car:

- The easiest route is from the M4 via the M32 feeder motorway which terminates at a T-junction with Bond Street – within sight of the hotel.
- The A4 from Bath and the A37 from Wells merge into Bath Road just off the adjacent map.
- From the A38 (South) or A4 (West) follow the signs for the Station (or M32) to the Bath Road on the adjacent map.

From the M32

- Stay on the M32 until its T-junction termination and third set of traffic lights moving into the leftmost lane.
- At this T-junction turn left. **Do not take the underpass**
- Take the slip road up to the large roundabout (Signpost Broadmead & A420) and move to the righthand lane.
- Take the third exit off the roundabout.
- Bear right into Lower Castle Street.
- Park in the NCP car park* adjacent to the hotel.

From the A4 (Bath), A37 (Wells) etc.

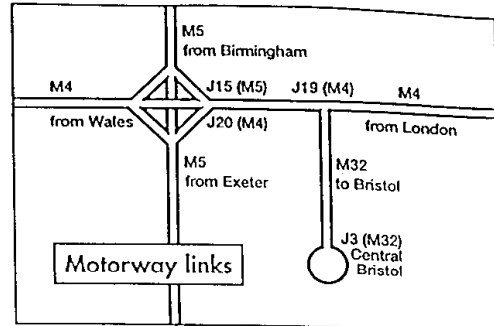
- Pass Temple Meads Station, keeping in the centre lane.
- Follow one-way route around the triangle and take the middle exit, heading for A420/M32.
- Coming off the triangle into Temple Way keep left.
- Take the slip road up (signpost A420) to the roundabout.
- Take the first exit off the roundabout (Broadmead).
- Bear right into Lower Castle Street.
- Park in the NCP car park* adjacent to the hotel.

*Complimentary parking at the NCP is available to hotel residents. Extra security is provided on floors 9 and 10. However, the hotel is not liable for any damage or loss whilst using this car park.

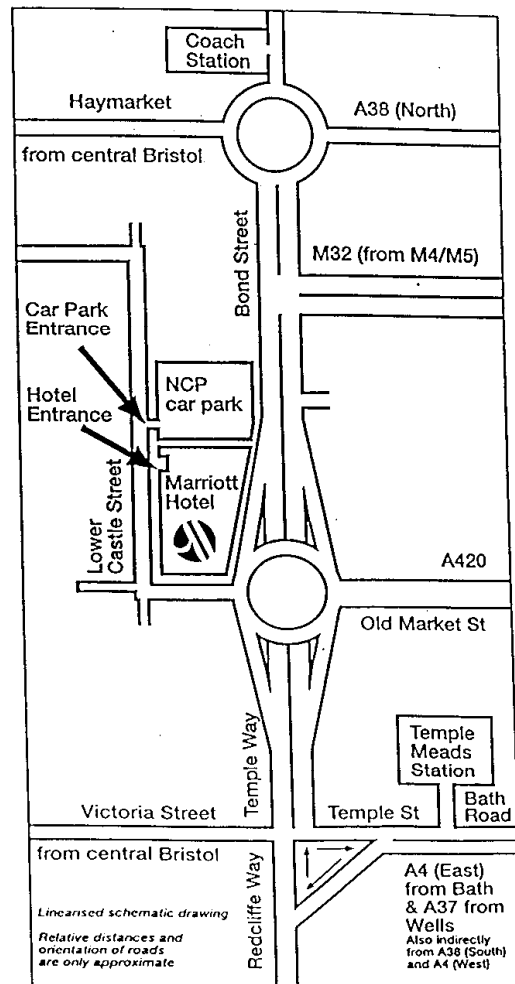

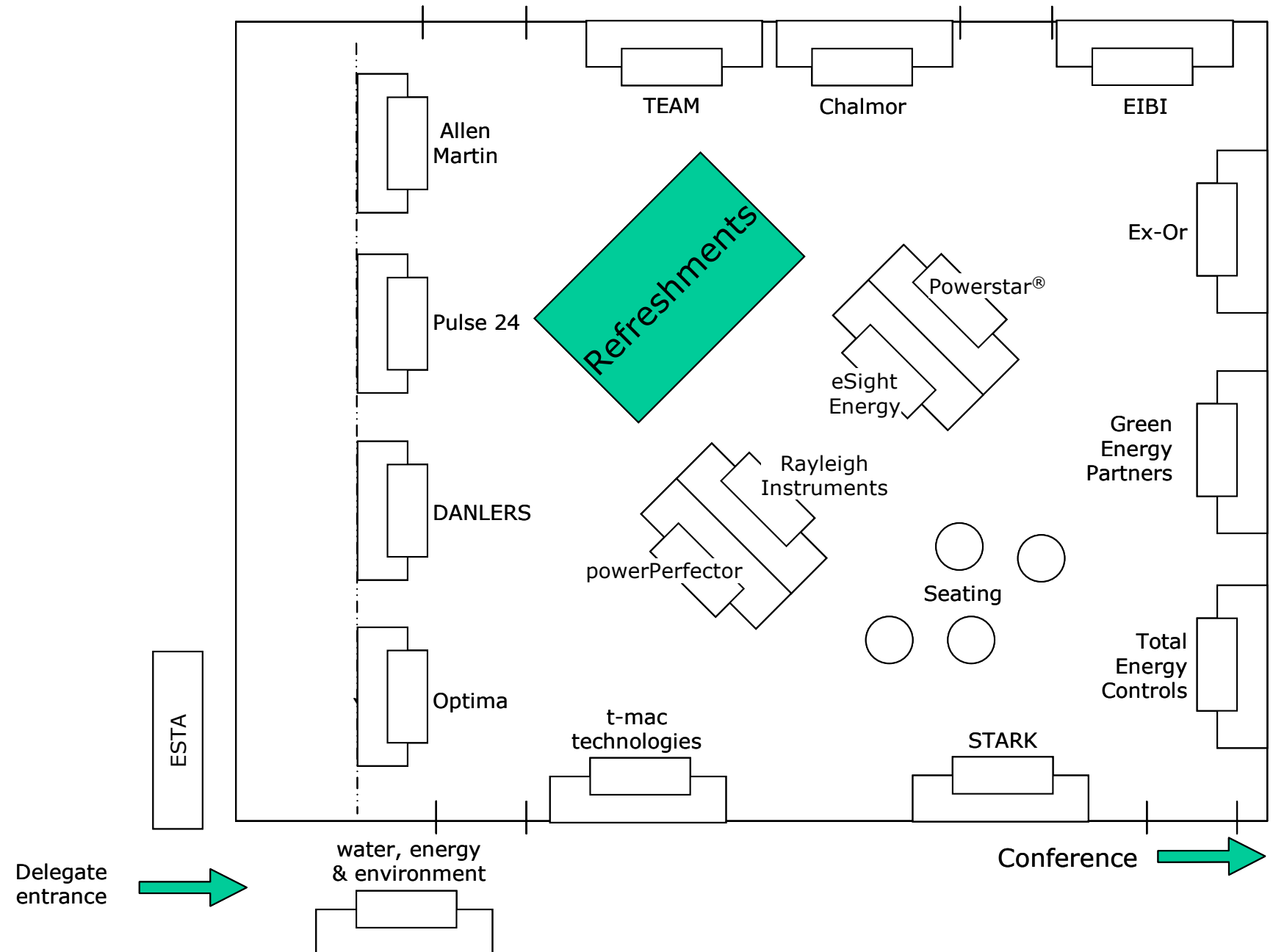
